

Terms & Conditions

1.0 Participation:

The Organizers reserve the rights to accept or refuse any application to take part in the exhibition or regarding displaying any exhibits without assigning any reason whatsoever. All decision of the Organizers to such effect shall be final. No reason for any such decision shall be given and no claim or objection from any exhibitor in relation there to shall be entertained. The Organizers reserve all rights to cancel the Exhibition three months before the due date and in such case shall refund all the payments made by the Exhibitor to the Organizers in relation to the Exhibition and Exhibitor hereby waives all right, actions and claims whatsoever for compensation under this Contract.

2.0 Payment of Rent:

2.1 Payment shall be made in full and final to ensure the allocation of required space.

2.2 An Exhibitor canceling or reducing his reserved space, shall not received a refund.

2.3 Any payment made does not necessarily guarantee allocation of the space until the stall/booth location has been approved by the Organizers.

3.0 Space Allocation & Usage:

3.1 The Organizers would do their utmost to allocate stalls/booths in the order of choices given, however in case these choices are already booked, alternative space will be allocated in any manner the Organizers deem fit and all decisions to such effect taken by the Organizers shall be final and binding upon the Exhibitor.

3.2 The Organizers are entitled in their absolute discretion to change, withdraw or otherwise deal with Exhibition Space allocated to an Exhibitor or change the dates and /or venue of the exhibition or alter the size and dimension of the Exhibition space or change/close entrances, exits and accesses to the Exhibition space, even if such matters have been confirmed, and in such circumstances, the Contract between the Organizers and the Exhibitor shall continue to bind the parties, as appropriate. Without prejudice to paragraph 9.3, any terms and conditions in any correspondence which do not conform to or are in addition to these rules and regulations shall not bind the Organizers unless such variation is expressly agreed in writing between the Organizers and the Exhibitor.

3.3 Exhibition space is let strictly to the Exhibitor and subject to the previous consent of the organizers, sub letting, assignment or parting with possession of any space, in favor of other person is not allowed. The Organizers reserve the right to cancel the participation of the Exhibitor in case stall / booth subletting is noticed.

3.4 The Organizers reserve the right to close any machine or device of the Exhibitor and remove it at any time before or during the Exhibition, if in the opinion of the Organizers, such machine or device is dangerous or causing inconvenience for others stall/booth holders or visitors. In case of resistance, the Organizers may remove such Exhibitor or his representatives from the Exhibition Halls with reasonable force, if necessary, at the expense of the Exhibitor, without the Organizers being liable for any loss or damage which may be occasioned by or through such removal.

4.0 Stalls/Booths/Bare Space & Exhibits:

Exhibitor must closely observe the following rules and cooperate with the Organizer's official contractor before the commencement of any work at the stall.

4.1 Shell scheme stalls/booths are all uniform design including the fascia with Exhibitor's name. No alteration or addition shall be made to the standard, fascia and lettering by Exhibitor.

4.2 All standard shells are framed with high quality material and the Exhibitor is forbidden to apply any poster, wall paper, paint, wallpaper paint drilling, nail or screw on the existing panels.

4.3 The Exhibitor may apply single or double-sided tapes on the existing panels. No glue, scotch tape, self-adhesive paper screw, nail, spike, pin or paint shall be used on floor, walls, pillars or any part of the Exhibition Hall.

4.4 Bare scheme stalls/booths Exhibitor shall employ his own contractors to erect and decorate his stall/booth but the detailed plan of the stall/booth shall be submitted to the Organizers of approval at least 45 days before the opening of the Exhibition. The Exhibitor shall make no alteration without the consent of the Organizers after the approval of the design.

4.5 The Exhibitor shall be responsible for removal of all waste and rubbish resulting from erection or dismantling from the Exhibition Hall. No storage facilities shall be provided for packaging cases, surplus materials or other belongings of the Exhibitors.

4.6 All containers, packing items and any items or articles not for display, must be removed, from the Exhibition Hall before the day of opening.

4.7 No pressurized container shall be used in the Exhibition Hall without the prior approval of the Organizers.

4.8 Height of the bare space stalls shall not exceed 8 feet, in case it is higher than 8 feet, it shall be kept minimum one meter distance from the adjoining stall.

4.9 In case of non-compliance with the terms and conditions, Organizers have all the rights to modify stall's layout during or after erection at the cost of the Exhibitor.

4.10 The exhibitor shall be liable for all losses, damages and costs resulting from a breach.

5.0 Operation of Stall/Booth:

5.1 No Stall/booth shall be left unattended at any time during the opening hours of the Exhibition. The Exhibitor's staff must be present at the relevant stall/booth at least 30 minutes before the opening hour and leave the Exhibition Hall not later than 30 minutes after the closing hour. The Exhibitor shall be responsible for the good conduct of his stall agents/representatives.

5.2 No sales activity shall be conducted by the Exhibitors outside the allocated stall / booth area. No advertising for business shall take place anywhere else in the Exhibition Hall.

5.3 No activity, which in the opinion of the Organizers, amounts to a nuisance or annoyance to others shall be caused by the Exhibitor, in particular, by the audiovisual equipment. The Organizers reserve the right to confiscate any audio/visual or other equipment which in their opinion, is offensive.

5.4 The Exhibitor shall submit all material particulars of the exhibits including weights and dimensions to the Organizers for their prior approval.

5.5 The unit weight of the exhibits shall not exceed the floor loading limit of 1785 kg/m².

5.6 The Exhibitor shall be responsible for damage to the structure or any part of the Exhibition Hall or other Exhibitor or Exhibits resulting from loading/unloading his Exhibits.

5.7 If an exhibit is displayed in working, safety and precaution must be taken for the protection of the Visitors through legible signs of "DANGER-DO NOT TOUCH" in English, displayed on a prominent place to warn the public. Exhibitor intending to demonstrate working equipment in his stall/booth must provide the Organizers in writing with full details of the working machinery concerned at least 45 days in advance and obtain the Organizer's written approval to this effect.

5.8 No exhibit is allowed to be taken into the stall/booth once the Exhibition has been officially opened unless special permission is given by the Organizers.

5.9 All exhibits shall be confined to the area of the Exhibition space allocated to the Exhibitor.

6.0 Electrical Work:

6.1 All electrical works for the stall/booth shall be carried out by the official contractor appointed by the Organizers

6.2 Extra electrical load, other than provided, will be charged extra and should be communicated to the organizer at 45 days before the exhibition.

6.3 No installation work can be carried out without the permission of the Organizers. Details of electrical installation shall be submitted to the Organizers for approval at least 45 days before the commencement of onsite works.

7.0 Insurance, Indemnity by the Exhibitor and the Organizers, exclusion of liability:

7.1 The Exhibitor must have at all times, valid and adequate insurance cover against theft, fire, public liability, damage to property, personal injury, third party loss, accidents, natural calamities, acts of God and such other risks normally insured against by exhibitors and/or as the Organizers may require, in connection with its activities during the Exhibition.

7.2 The Exhibitor's articles brought into the stall and taken out shall be entirely at the Exhibitor's own risk, who shall be responsible for the safety of his belongings at all the times.

7.3 The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify the Organizers against all and any action, claims, demands, losses (including consequential losses), proceedings, damages, liabilities, cost and expenses incurred by or made against the Organizers in connection with (a) any breach of any of these terms, rules and regulations, or/and applicable laws and regulations by the Exhibitor or (b) any act, omission, default or negligence of, or loss or damage caused by the Exhibitor in connection with any other person, the Exhibition and the Exhibition Halls.

7.4 The Organization shall not be liable for any losses (including consequential losses), damages, demands, costs, claims, charges or other expenses of any kind suffered or incurred by the Exhibitor in connection with the Exhibition including, but not limited to, any theft, fire, defect in the Exhibition Halls howsoever caused, cancellation or early closure of, or delay in the opening or closing of, the Exhibition for whatever reason outside the control of the Organizers, any matter referred to in the paragraph 3.2 of these terms, rules and regulations, any natural calamity or any act of God, howsoever arising. The Exhibitor shall be liable to any third party for any claims of injury or damage arising from his stalls/booths and its portion.

7.5 If the Exhibition is cancelled or closed early for whatever reasons beyond the control of the Organizers, the Organizer's obligations under this Contract shall be absolutely discharged with immediate effect as from the date of cancellation or early closure in such circumstances. The Organizers shall not be obliged to refund any rental payments made by the Exhibitor to the Organizers in relation to the Exhibition and shall not be liable for any losses (including consequential losses), damage, demands, costs, claims, charges or other expenses of any kind arising in respect thereof. The Exhibitor must insure against any such events occurring.

8.0 Moving in & out of the Exhibition Halls:

8.1 The organizers shall provide each Exhibitor with a schedule for moving his exhibits and other articles into his stall/booth, which shall be strictly followed.

8.2 All exhibits/component materials shall be removed soon after closure of the Exhibition and accomplished within 24 hours; materials left behind shall be deemed forsaken. The costs incurred for the removal of any such items shall be borne by the Exhibitor.

8.3 All goods must be moved/transported by rubber-tired trolleys over protective boarding.

9.0 Others:

9.1 Any work carried out by the Exhibitor in Pakistan must be in accordance with the current local laws and regulations. Any contravention of these conditions will be entirely at Exhibitor's risk and cost. The Organizers shall not hold any responsibility for any costs or consequences in this respect.

9.2 Failure of the Exhibitor at any time before or during the Exhibition to comply with any of the Exhibition terms and condition shall automatically deprive the Exhibitor of his right to participate any further in the Exhibition and no claim for refund of any rental paid shall be entertained by the Organizers.

9.3 The Organizers reserve the right to alter and amend any of the terms, conditions and regulations and issue additional rules they deem necessary for the orderly conducting of the Exhibition. Any dispute or difference arising out of the interpretation of these terms, conditions & regulations or regarding the rights, duties and obligations of the Exhibitor shall be decided by the Organizers whose decision shall be final and binding upon the Exhibitor.

9.4 For the purposes of these terms, rules and regulations, the expressions Organizers, Exhibitor, Exhibition & Exhibition Hall means the respective parties, event and venue.

9.5 'Exhibitor' includes any of the Exhibitor's employees, agents, contractors, sub-contractors, sub-licensees and/or assignees.

9.6 Organizers include the Organizer's employees, directors, officers, contractors, sub-contractors and authorized agents, assignees.

9.7 Exhibitor shall not depute persons under the age of 18 at his stall / booth.

10.0 Correspondences / Forms Filing Dates:

The Exhibitor hereby agrees to accomplish all the requisite formalities in the prescribed time limit as instructed by the Organizers. The information received will be treated as final and authentic. Any information received after the deadline shall not be entertained.

11.0 Dress Code:

All male exhibitors will wear full pants and shirt. All female staff would observe decent business dress.

12.0 Alcohols:

Use of alcoholic beverages, drinking or serving to the visitors is prohibitive and punishable under the law.

13.0 Law of the Land:

Any legal offence or dispute shall be dealt in accordance with the laws of Pakistan.
